



Announcement for cargo arrangement of Wellington, New Zealand after the earthquake

According to the latest notice from Centreport Wellington, New Zealand, affected by the huge earthquake on 14th Nov., Wellington port may still be unable to resume working in the next two months due to the serious damage of the terminal.

During this period, taking into account the Wellington port / terminal / container yard and roads already cannot afford the related service for shipping, in order to ensure the service, here is the arrangement for Wellington port import & export cargoes from COSCO SHIPPING LINES:

For Wellington import cargo: all will be discharged at Napier port (which is the nearest from Wellington), and customers own the transshipment from Napier to the destination.

For Wellington export cargo: customer should own the transshipment from the receipt region to the containers yard of COSCO SHIPPING LINES in Napier or Tauranga to be arranged on sea transportation.

COSCO SHIPPING LINES will pay close attention to the recovery of Wellington port, and update the concerned information the first time. Sorry for any inconvenience caused. Thank you!
